C.16 PRIVATE LESSONS AT NORTH COUNTRY

As a matter of policy and in accord with accepted professional practices, teachers do not charge students for tutoring or private teaching. However, there is a recognized exception where private instruction is allowed outside of the regular school day and in addition to the regular school program.

Teachers of music, with prior approval of the administration, may teach private lessons in the school after 6:00 p.m. on school days and all day on Saturday. This instruction is not to replace lessons given free during the regular school time.

None of these activities or lessons may take place in school on Sunday.

At North Country Junior High School consideration by the administration and the school board will be given to requests from parents/guardians for private instruction during school hours by non-employees of the district, which meet the following criteria:

- * the private instruction augments the student's educational program based upon a review by the child's team and the administration
- * the area of private instruction supplements and does not replace instruction presently offered at NCUJHS
- * the private instruction occurs during non-instructional portions of the day for the student(s) involved
- * all private instruction costs are born by the parent/guardian of the child involved
- * use of instructional space for private instruction does not conflict with regular school programs.
- * the suitability and availability of appropriate space in the building

Any request for private lessons deemed to be appropriate after review by the student's team and principal will be presented to the school board meeting for final consideration.
